Responsibilities Include:

- Complete safety surveys to ensure clients' compliance with governmental safety regulations (OSHA, FMCSA, EPA), Life safety codes (NFPA), and sound safety principles.
- Analyze client claims experience and accident/incident data to determine trends and develop/recommend control programs to minimize losses.
- Provide safety consultations to the customer as needed.
- Develop safety service strategies for risk control programs.
- Monitor account safety services to ensure that delivery is proper, on time, and cost effective.
- Assists producer (sales) and marketing efforts by interfacing with clients and insurance risk control representatives during the underwriting process, or as necessary.
- Assist client through OSHA inspections and accident investigations, and recordkeeping/reporting efforts.
- Train client supervisors in procedures and practices associated with safety management, as needed.
- Assist in clients' employee safety training programs, including new employee orientation, as needed.
